Institute News

International Conference on Disaster Mitigation Through Fire Safety & Earthquake Engineering

An international conference "Disaster Mitigation through Fire Safety and Earthquake Engineering" was held on March 29, 2010 at Ahmedabad. The conference was collaboratively organized by the Gujarat State Disaster Management Authority





(GSDMA), IIT Gandhinagar and Underwriters Laboratory, USA. Honourable Chief Minister of Gujarat, Sri Narendra Modi, in his inaugural address, emphasized the very high priority that Gujarat has been placing on disaster mitigation since the 2001 earthquake.

International Collaborative Research Opportunity For Undergraduate Students

A joint research initiative by Underwriters Laboratory (UL), Northbrook, USA and IITGN attracted 80 IITGN students to take up the challenge to come up with innovative ideas to reduce hazards for fire fighters in urban India, and to create a database for fire related disasters in the country. Students visited Fire Services at Delhi, Mumbai and Ahmedabad, including a 10 days stay in Delhi during December 2009 and interacted with Fire Department officials during these visits. The students were mentored in their research efforts by UL experts from US and India and the Fire Chiefs of Delhi, Maharashtra and Ahmedabad. Students, working in teams of 2 each, presented their ideas during 30-31 January 2010. The jury panel lauded the research work of the young participants, and selected the following four teams as winners for the Conceptualization Phase of the project:

Team 1: Anchit Gauray and Adnan Ahmad Ansari

Team2: Vivek Yadav and Abhishek Umrao

Team3: Saurya Prakash Sinha and Divyank Singh

Team4: Shruti Jain and Ekta Prashnani

All participating students received certificates for their efforts. The four winning teams are now working on developing the technology/database. To facilitate their work, all eight students have been granted three weeks internships at UL, Northbrook, USA during summer 2010. The winning teams were also invited to present their ideas at a dinner on March 28, 2010 during the International Conference on Disaster Mitigation through Fire Safety and Earthquake Engineering. The teams will submit their Phase-II reports by October 2010. Phase-III of the project will involve implementation. This collaborative research initiative will continue next year with new challenges.
