CIRCULAR

Semester-end-re-examination

In accordance with the Senate decision, taken at its 1st meeting held on 24th April, 2010, a student who have been awarded FF grade can avail 50 marks re-examination. Similarly, students awarded 'II', are eligible for a semester-end re-examination on medical grounds / valid reasons, on production of medical certificate issued / authenticated by Medical Officer, IIT Gandhinagar. Please note that in accordance with the rules, students are provided with only one chance to appear for the re-examination before the commencement of the next semester. Place holder grades (FF/II), are liable to be converted to "FR" grade, after the semester-end-re-examination / before commencement of the next semester.

In view of the above, those students who have obtained FF/II grade in the semester-end examination 2009-10, are advised to make use of the opportunity and clear their backlog through semester-end-re-examination **to be held on 19th and 20th July, 2010.**

The students can register for re-examination latest by 12th July, 2010. Re-examination forms are available on the Institute web site.

In view of the ongoing discussions relating to the quantum of fees for semester end re-examinations, no fees are being prescribed for the re-examinations being held in July 2010 as per the schedule given above.

Applications received **after the due date will not be entertained.** Also note that there will be no re-examinations for re-examinations on any grounds whatsoever, and failure to appear in the re-examination will entail conversion of FF/II grades into FR grades.
