INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

1. The candidates must report on time for Written Test and/or Interview.
2. Candidates are advised to ensure that they fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria and bring a copy of his/her application, a passport size photograph, self-attested photocopies of his/her marksheets, degree certificates (if available) and GATE score card at the time of test/interview.
3. Students joining regular M.Tech programme will be considered for fellowship/stipend based on the laid down norms.
4. The candidates belonging to SC/ST category must submit self-attested copy of the caste certificate at the time of test/interview.
5. The candidates belonging to OBC- non-creamy layer category must submit self-attested copy of the latest OBC caste and non-creamy layer certificate at the time of test/interview.
6. Persons with disability have to bring necessary certificates regarding minimum 40% disability at the time of written test/interview for consideration.
7. Candidates(M.Tech Regular/PGDIIT) called for the Test/Interview will be reimbursed any amount exceeding Rs.750/- for to and fro single second-sleeper class railway fare by the shortest route from their place of residence to the Institute /venue of the Test / Interview. For example, in case of total railway fare of Rs.1000/- the candidate will be reimbursed Rs.250/-. It is required to produce evidence (railway ticket) in support of the claim
8. List of candidates shortlisted on the basis of performance in the written test, and eligible to appear for the interviews will be put up on the Institute Notice Board on the same day.
9. If selected, you are required to pay fees and deposits etc and hostel rent as applicable within the stipulated time to confirm your admission.
10. The Institute reserves the right to withdraw the admission in case candidate DOES NOT fulfill minimum qualification / required percentage of marks in qualifying examination or supplies any false information.
